End of the Road: Fugitive of Justice from Multiple States Taken into Custody

On Friday, April 18th, at approximately 1:20 pm, Officer Reyes was on patrol when he observed a vehicle stopped in the roadway in the area of 46 Madison Street. The vehicle had an improper license plate frame covering the license plate. A DMV inquiry of the vehicle and the operator revealed that the operator of the vehicle had his New York State driving privileges revoked. The registered owner of the vehicle was identified as Mr. Christopher Arroyo, a 43-year-old male resident from Mamaroneck. The same portal inquiry revealed that Mr. Arroyo was wanted out of Las Vegas, Nevada, and Carol Stream, Illinois for Burglary in the First Degree and Assault with a Weapon. Both warrants were fully extraditable, however the vehicle left the scene, before officers could stop it.

A brief canvass of the area was conducted. To assist officers in locating the vehicle, they utilized advanced law enforcement technology. Officers were alerted that the vehicle was heading back into the Village of Mamaroneck on Boston Post Road. Officers responded to the area and found the vehicle exiting the McDonald's Restaurant parking lot located on Boston Post Road. A traffic stop was conducted, and the operator of the vehicle was Mr. Arroyo, he was quickly taken into custody without incident and transported to Police Headquarters, where he was charged with "Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the Third Degree," which is a misdemeanor. Both Police Departments: Las Vegas and Chicago advised that they would be filing extradition charges to pick up the Mr. Arroyo.

A Fugitive of Justice Warrant was completed and filed with the Court. The defendant was arraigned in Village Court and remanded to the Westchester County Department of Corrections.

Alert and acute observation skills, along with utilizing 21st-century modern-day policing software, allowed Officer Reyes and his fellow officers to bring this fugitive to justice to respond for multiple serious charges in two different states.
